Renovation and refurbishing for Boys Residence (8 apartments) | \$30,000 | Oyarifa, Ghana

Renovate Dormitories: We urgently need your support to raise \$30,000 for the renovation of the Agape Children's Home boys' residence. This renovation will provide a safe and nurturing environment for our boys, ensuring they have a comfortable place to call home.

Rescue Fund & Renovation and Refurbishing of Boy's Residence

Rescue Fund | \$50,000 | Oyarifa, Ghana

The Rescue fund at Agape Gospel Mission provides funding that enables us to rescue orphans and vulnerable children and accept them immediately into residential care. The rescue fund bridges the gap for the first six months of a child's stay as we solicit ongoing monthly support for the children from recurring donors. The funds are used to care for a child as we raise child sponsors, and to provide for the additional costs of intake such as vaccinations, medical assessment, and initial treatment and clothing.

Expand our Capacity to Provide Quality Christ-Centered Education

Expansion Project | \$427,000 | Oyarifa, Ghana

We need new classrooms so that we can educate the many new children we will rescue this year. We have executed an agreement to buy a property adjacent to our current school campus which will allow us to expand our enrolment.



Agape Churches and Evangelism

Agape Churches | \$200,000 | Africa & the Middle East

We need support to plant new churches and strengthen existing churches in Africa. For over 40 years, Agape Gospel Mission has planted churches in under-served communities in Africa. Our churches are reaching people facing dire poverty, frequent Islamist insurgencies, and opposition from those worshipping idols. They need our ongoing support to reach the lost and raise disciples, even in the face of persecution and poverty.

Nigeria: Establishing new church plants in under-served areas and hotspots of Christian persecution.

Sierra Leone: We are providing resources for existing churches to expand their outreach in Freetown and Bo.

Benin, Zambia, Liberia: Specific projects include building new worship centers and community halls.

Budget Breakdown

Nigeria, Kenya, Benin - New Church Plants: \$40,000

Sierra Leone Expansion: \$25,000 Zambia and Liberia Projects: \$60,000 Ghana churches support: \$75,000



Agape Media Ministry \$50,000 | Accra, Ghana

Agape Media Ministry is reaching millions of people around the world with the Gospel. God is using our broadcasts to reach the lost and disciple believers in the truth.

Broadcasting Equipment: Upgrading cameras, microphones, and editing software to improve the quality of sermons and programs.

New Platforms: Expanding reach through social media and other digital platforms. Pastor Whitcomb's Truth for Today gospel broadcasts reach 5 million people weekly.

AGM's NET is dedicated full time to winning souls for Christ through street preaching, school outreaches, hospital visitation, and evangelism events across Ghana. NET works in conjunction with our local AGM Churches to evangelize the lost and establish the new believers in church. NET is helping thousands in Ghana come to faith in Jesus. We are doubling the size of our Team in 2025 from the original four members to eight full-time missionary evangelists. Help us pay for their operation budget for 2025.

We offer a full-time residency training program at Agape Bible College, where students earn an accredited theological degree and gain ministry experience at our Agape churches. Upon graduation, our students are ready to preach the word of God, make disciples, and plant new churches across Africa.

Administration & New Training Materials: Updating curriculum and purchasing new books and resources.


RESCUE
